The virtual assistant has pre-packaged and conversationally formatted question-and-answer screening content as per the guidelines for a preliminary test to analyse the symptoms and provide guidance for the steps ahead accordingly.

The private laboratories as per the government's mandate can conduct real-time polymerase chain reaction (PCR) based test. Also, only a certified phlebotomist will collect the test samples directly from the patient's home. The personnel will take necessary precautionary measures as per ICMR guidelines while taking the throat and nasal swabs for the test. The collected sample will be sent to these laboratories for COVID-19 detection testing. The report will be made available to the patients within 24-48 hours of the sample collection.
